Jake Wiebe (Hampton Place): the budget line for the Office / Administration be broken down more in the future with a clearer description; if the Reserves are invested and if so at what rate of return.

Answer: Office and Administration costs include: all Board costs, communications costs, special projects of the Board. The Reserves are invested with UBC and the UNA receives over 2% interest.

Gary Gibson (Hampton Place): who was paying for the new community centre and if there may be any grants available.

Answer: The new community centre will be paid for by UBC and operated by the UNA.

Alexandra Wallcock (Hawthorn Place): concern about the sustainability of the sprinkler system coming on in the middle of the night.

Answer: The sprinklers use relatively little water compared with domestic consumption. It is actually more efficient to leave sprinklers on than to install sensors.
